

***Immediate Request:***  
**Benghazi, Libya**  
**Acute Trauma Surgeons**

Medical Missions Response ([mmronline.org](http://mmronline.org)) is looking for acute trauma surgeons (orthopedic, vascular and general surgery) that could go short notice to Benghazi, Libya. This is due to war issues and disruption of social institutions and delivery, in this case hospitals. Surgery would be focused on trauma but also any issues in these realms which appear.

The amount of time to stay is up to the volunteer, but preference would be given to those that can stay one month or more. Two week time frames of total travel would be acceptable.

The personnel is being asked to work in a hospital with acute trauma patients. No prearranged visas are necessary, and good contacts are on the ground in the area to coordinate the stay and work.

The estimated project cost for a two week stay is \$1800 (\$4,700 for a one month stay) not counting airfare and transportation costs to Alexandria, Egypt. Though, it is possible that the cost could come down significantly if the volunteer chose to stay in one of the hospitals and eat cheaply.

MMR will arrange travel for the volunteers to Alexandria, Egypt and arrangements will be made onto Benghazi. Arrangements will be coordinated on the ground in Benghazi with known entities. MMR will arrange for volunteer insurance. More details can be given.
