TO: Medical Volunteers

We are thankful for those who have responded to the needs in Haiti.

Our work continues at Petionville Community Hospital. In addition, we are providing ongoing support at St. Damiens, a children's hospital. We hope to begin mobile clinics this week.

Housing is in a compound that provides lodging, food, and security.

Typical trip at this point begins in the US with a flight to Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. The team stays the night in a church, then takes a bus ride to Haiti the following day. The team works 6 days, then returns to Santo Domingo, flying out the next day. Basically, 4 days of travel, 6 days of work. This schedule will change when we are able to secure reliable, affordable airfare into Port-au-Prince airport.

Cost for NC volunteers is \$850. This covers airfare, lodging, in-country ground transportation, food, water and accident insurance.

Out-of-state volunteer cost is airfare + \$250.

To participate, you must: 1. Be a Christian 2. Posses a current, unencumbered medical license 3. Not have any current or pending litigation or disciplinary action against you.

If you meet the above criteria and want to participate, please follow these steps:

NC Residents:

Step 1: complete a profile at ncmissions.org by clicking on "sign-in" in upper right corner, complete the username and password then the rest of the 'My Profile' info in **all** of the tabs.

2. Go to servnc.org and complete a profile (this help us check your credentials) at the "Affiliation" section, associate yourself with North Carolina Baptist Men Medical Reserve Corps.

3. Choose a date that you want to participate and email it to me. I will let you know if you are on the team.

Out-of-State residents:

Step 1: complete a profile at ncmissions.org by clicking on "sign-in" in upper right corner, complete the username and password then the rest of the 'My Profile' info in **all** of the tabs.

2. Scan or mail legible copies of your medical credentials.

3. Ask your employer to certify that you posses an unencumbered medical license by sending a notarized letter stating such on company letterhead. If self-employed, locate a 3rd party to provide this certification

4. Choose a date that you want to participate and email it to me. I will let you know if you are on the team.
