

## **Ministries of Jesus Patient Dismissal Policy**

Ministries of Jesus is a non-profit, no cost center for the purpose of ministering to the whole person spirit, soul, and body. Because of our limited mission statement and limited resources we reserve the right to refuse to treat any patient.

1. If we do not have the resources to provide the perceived need of the patient we can refuse to treat that patient.
2. If a patient is deemed to be uncooperative, overly aggressive, or behaviorally unmanageable we can refuse to treat the patient.
3. If a patient is deemed to be dangerous to self or others we can refuse to treat that patient.
4. If a patient is found to be consistently untruthful we can refuse to treat that patient.
5. If a patient is deemed to be beyond our scope of care we can refuse to treat that patient.
6. If it is a new patient without a record we can simply refuse to see them, but should try to provide them with the names of other resources to try.
7. If it is a patient of record being dismissed, we must:
  - a. Inform the patient by return receipt requested letter.
  - b. Offer to provide services for 30 days after the date of the receipt of the letter.
  - c. Provide in the letter a list of alternative resources the patient can possibly utilize.
