Who We Are:

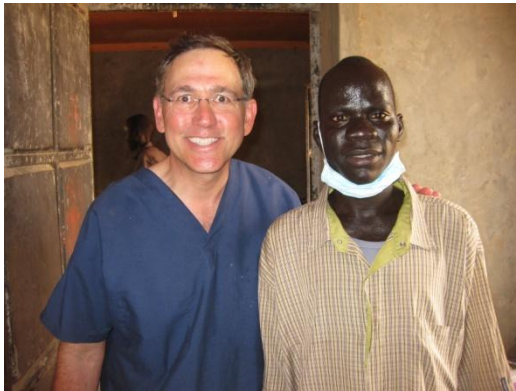
Make Way Partners is a Christian mission agency committed to preventing and combating human trafficking and all forms of modern-day slavery by *educating* and *mobilizing* the Body of Christ.

Passionate to share the hope of the Gospel with the least of these, Make Way Partners uses two criteria to select places of ministry:

1. Where women & children are at highest risk of human trafficking, forced prostitution and other forms of modern-day slavery.
2. Where little to no other help is available because it is considered either "too dangerous," "too expensive" or "too remote" for most people to go.

What We Do:

Make Way Partners has built and fully supports an indigenously run orphan care network in Southern Sudan.

In Nyamlel, South Sudan we partner with Indigenous Director James Lual Atak at *New Life Ministry* to provide home, education, discipleship and medical care to 550 orphans. New Life Ministry also provides jobs and training to women who have escaped from slavery or who have been widowed.

In Torit, South Sudan we support *Hope for Sudan*, directed by Romano Oguma Nero. Hope for Sudan is our newest orphan home and provides total care for over 50 orphans.

Make Way Partners works to accomplish long term change by partnering with indigenous pastors who have a heart for the Gospel and for “the least of these.”

Short Term Medical/Dental Teams Needed in Nyamlel, Sudan!

There is great need in this region for Medical and Dental teams. We are planning a short term mission team to Nyamlel, Sudan for **February 9-19**.

The 550 orphans of New Life Ministry, the staff, and the village of Nyamlel desperately need medical care. This region suffers the effects of 50 years of war as well as harsh climate, tropical disease, polluted water, and sexual violence. Medical missions in Nyamlel, Sudan presents an opportunity to be the hands and feet of Jesus Christ in a war torn region. In Southern Sudan, in general, the people’s hearts are very open to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and we have in place indigenous pastors who can follow up our medical and evangelistic efforts with continued discipleship.

All Categories of Health Professionals are Needed

General Practitioners, Gynecologists, Pediatricians, Dentists, Nurses, Paramedics – any and all medical professionals who have a heart for Jesus Christ and for the suffering have something to offer! *This short term medical team will work hand in hand with the indigenous medical staff who are on site year round.*

General Medical Need:

In addition to the short term benefits, two major long term benefits will arise from physician involvement in a short term medical team: 1) our indigenous medical staff will receive valuable training, which will result in 2) Our children being more likely to be correctly diagnosed and treated in the future.

Much need exists in the communities surrounding our facilities. Diseases such as malaria, typhoid, meningitis, and yellow fever are rampant in East Africa as well as complications arising from heat, polluted water, and malnutrition. In Sudan especially there are few medical facilities and people often walk many miles to see a doctor- when they often do not have money to pay for treatment. Doctors and medical staff who can offer medical treatment to the communities surrounding our facilities further endear our facilities in the hearts of the local populations (which ensures safety for the children we protect) and create an excellent opportunity to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ!

Gynecological Need:

Many women and children in Sudan have been victims of unimaginable sexual violence. Much need exists for gynecologists who are willing to offer examinations, training, and education to the women and girls of our facilities as well as to the surrounding communities. *Much need exists in the area of training regarding birthing practices.*

Dental Need:

The children of **New Life Ministry** experienced major malnutrition before coming under our care. As a result, the dental need is great. Many of the children suffer from toothaches and abscesses, with no opportunity for relief. Much need exists both for extraction and training. Medical Facilities:

The New Life Ministry compound is equipped with a brick and mortar medical clinic building. This serves as the clinic for our children year round and provides the base for our visiting medical teams.

Cost:

The cost of this trip is \$5,000 per person. We are traveling to one of the most difficult to reach regions of the world – just a few miles south of the Darfur region. The cost includes:

- Round trip international flight to Nairobi, Kenya
- Accommodations in Nairobi for one night on each end of the trip, as well as taxi service in Nairobi.
- Trip Insurance in case of an emergency medical issue.
- Charter flight via a missionary aviation group (AIM Air or MAF) round trip from Nairobi, Kenya to Nyamlel, Sudan (this is the most expensive part of the trip).

Accommodations in Sudan:

The mission teams sleep under a large shelter which offers shade, in tents for privacy and protection from mosquitoes. Cots are provided for some extra comfort. There is no “Holiday Inn” in Nyamlel! This trip is truly a sacrifice of comfort, but well worth it.

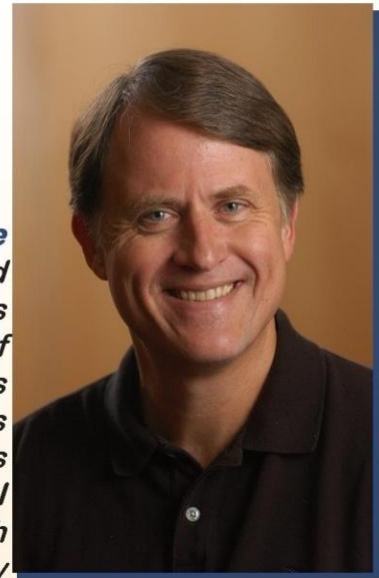

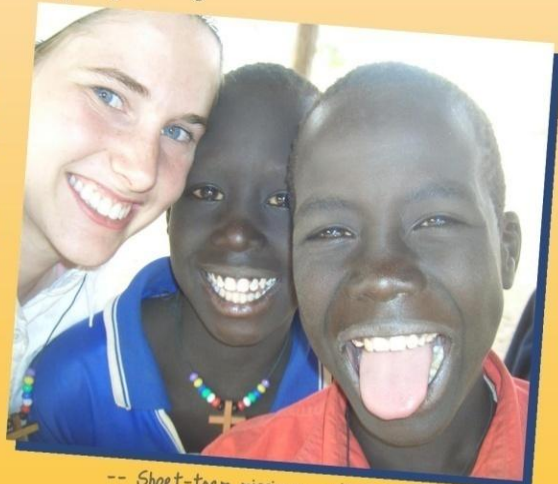
Passionate to share the Hope of the Gospel with the least of these, **Make Way Partners** uses two criteria to select places of ministry:
