David Howard, CCBA Director of Missions, will be the organizer of this group and will facilitate the required training sessions.

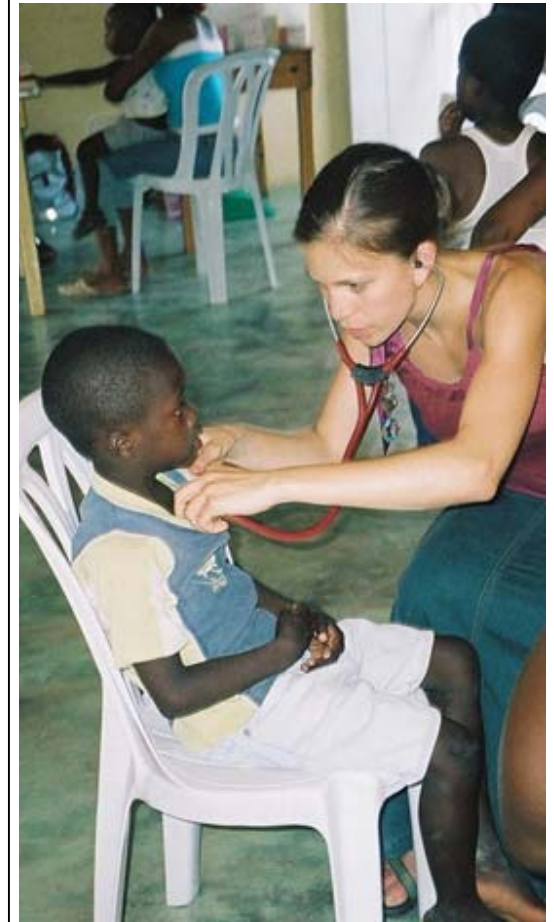
